Building Information Modeling -

Getting Used to the Interface –

- No layers, no coordinates, no colours: this is an improvement?

3D Views –

- Are plans obsolete?



Creating a Structural Model -

- Smart objects placed with intelligence: better than the alternative.
- If Revit doesn't supply it, you can make it.

Detailing –

- Can you actually draft in Revit?
- Plays well with CAD.

Documentation –

- On schedule, under budget.
- Get cosy between the sheets



Collaboration –

- Share the model, not just emails

Design considerations for the Structural Engineer:

- How accurate should the model be?
- What to model
- When to stop
